Mahwah Senior Activity Center:

Rules & Regulations for Senior Bus Trips

- 1.) Mahwah Senior Activity Center trips, like all other programs offered at the Center, are open to all Mahwah residents age 62 or older. (Seats may be given to out-of town residents for an additional charge of \$ 20.00 p.p. ONLY if seats are not filled by Mahwah residents AND at the discretion of the Senior Director.)

- 2.) Please keep in mind that space is limited on the trips. A first come first serve system will be implemented to ensure a fair method for booking. Names of interested participants must be submitted to Susanne Small at the Mahwah Activity Center (201) 529-5757 X 213
(Couples and group names must be submitted together.)
- 3.) A *waiting list* will be compiled. The cost of the trip will be posted on the flyer for the trip. This price includes round trip transportation from the Mahwah Municipal Complex. The tip is included.
(Note: Some trips include lunch and entertainment costs, while others do *not*.)
- 4.) The money for the trip is due immediately. Checks are preferable and should be made payable to "Air Brook Limousine" or other specified trip provider.
- 5.) Monies are refundable only if the Senior Director is able to arrange a replacement with a senior from the waiting list.
- 6.) Bus departs sharply at time posted on the flyer; therefore, it is recommended that you arrive 15 minutes prior to departure time. The bus will always leave from the upper or lower parking lot, and it will leave *promptly* at the posted time. Those who fail to board the bus on time will forfeit the trip and will not receive a refund.
- 7.) Preference for bus seating will also be awarded by a first come first serve basis, as payment is received.
- 8.) Participations with canes, walkers or wheelchairs have priority with regards to seats in the front of the bus. If you have difficulty walking, please discuss this in advance. A senior who functions **independently** or who has a companion to provide whatever individual assistance is needed may participate in trip activities at the center.
- 9.) When leaving a location on the trip itinerary, it is important that all seniors return to the meeting place at the time announced. The bus will leave **promptly** from that location and **will not wait**.
- 10.) Any behavior by a participant which inhibits any other participant from enjoying the trip, or which negatively affects the safety of the participants, is inappropriate, including:
 - a. Offensive, shouting or loud discourse
 - b. Threatening or intimidating behavior or language
 - c. Offensive hygiene
 - d. Solicitation for personal or improper purpose
 - e. Harassment and/or discrimination on the basis of race, sex, religion, color, age, handicap, national origin or sexual orientation
 - f. Standing and walking on the bus during the ride
- 11.) This policy is intended to make participants feel welcome and to provide reasonable rules of behavior, enforced for the benefit of all participants.
- 12.) Inappropriate behavior may result in the loss of Senior Center privileges or immediate expulsion.
Note: the Senior Activity Director has the sole authority regarding trips and excursions.
