Join us as the caretakers of the rich history that has been passed to us by previous generations. Help us preserve their heritage for future generations. Current projects include:

- The **Old Lutheran Cemetery** groundskeeping, site stabilization, and gravestone restoration. This is the oldest Cemetery in Mahwah with gravestones dating from 1745. Over the next few years the land must be stabilized with new retaining walls to prevent irreversible erosion.
- The **Quackenbush Barn** at Winters Park, a unique early 19th Century English-style bank barn in the perfect shade of red! The Barn has become a local favorite spot for fall family photos! It needs a new roof and ongoing repairs due to animal damage and vandalism.
- The **Wanamaker Shed** (C. 1830), a rustic utility shed moved to the Old Train Station Museum complex from the Island Road property that was originally owned by Pieter Wanamaker in 1713, shortly after he came from Germany. The Wanamaker House was destroyed in 1968. This remnant is all that remains. The wood-shingled roof is in need of repair.
