

**TOWNSHIP OF MAHWAH
ORDINANCE NO 1932**

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAHWAH, COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER 12, FIRE PERMITS, OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO REVISE CERTAIN PERMIT FEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NEW JERSEY UNIFORM FIRE CODE

WHEREAS, Chapter 12, Fire Prevention, of the Township Code sets forth certain fees for fire permits, in accordance with the New Jersey Uniform Fire Code, N.J.A.C. 5:70-1.1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs periodically revises the permit fees in the Uniform Fire Code; and

WHEREAS, the Township Fire Official recommends revising Chapter 12 of the Township Code to reflect fees set forth in N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.9(c) and N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.9(d)2 of the Uniform Fire Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Mahwah, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follow:

SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Fire Prevention, Section 12-1.8, Additional Required Inspections and Fees, paragraph g, Certificate of Smoke Detector Installation, of the Code of the Township of Mahwah is hereby amended to read as follows:

g. Certificate of Smoke Detector Installation: \$90.

SECTION 2. Chapter 12, Fire Prevention, Section 12-1.9, Permits, of the Code of the Township of Mahwah is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 12-1.9 Permits.

Application fees for permits shall be as set forth below, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:70-2.9(c) for Types 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Type 1 Fire Permit - \$54.00

Type 2 Fire Permit - \$214.00

Type 3 Fire Permit - \$427.00

Type 4 Fire Permit - \$641.00 (except for storage activity at a premises registered as a life hazard use in accordance with N.J.S.A. 5:70-2.9.

Type 5 Fire Permit – no charge

Fees for single event individual permits shall be paid at the time of application. All other permit fees are annual permit fees and are to be paid on January 1st of each year for the calendar year for which the same is paid or payable.

SECTION 3. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days following final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.


