

**TOWNSHIP OF MAHWAH
ORDINANCE NO. 1954**

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAHWAH, COUNTY OF BERGEN,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REPEALING §2-19 MUNICIPAL POOL
COMMISSION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAHWAH CODE.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-1 et seq., the New Jersey Legislature delegated to municipalities the responsibility to promulgate regulations designed to promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has determined that it is necessary and appropriate, and in the best interest of the streamlining the Township government and to promote more efficient operation, thereof to repeal portion of the Township Code establishing the Municipal Pool Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council at a later date will establish a Pool Committee to serve the community and residents of the Township, and members of the public who use the Mahwah Township Pool; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council desires to amend the Township Code to implement these changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Mahwah, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Administration, § 2-19, Municipal Pool Commission, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days following final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
